Job Summary and Key Objectives: This college student intern will provide mechanical CAD design for specific products and parts. In addition they will assist with product assembly and debug, assist with product testing and create product documentation. There may be opportunities to work on special one-off projects, represent AndyMark at summer events, and collaborate with other departments. This position will work with AndyMark engineers and administration, and will require the student to work on various tasks daily.

Key Responsibilities and Tasks: Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the responsibilities and tasks.

- Provides mechanical 3D CAD design for specific products and parts
- Assists with designing and building prototype products
- Assists with product testing and evaluation and the appropriate documentation
- Assembles products and parts
- Creates detailed manufacturing and engineering drawings for production
- Operates production equipment, as needed
- Assist AndyMark staff at *FIRST* and other off-season events
- Manages project information through software communication tools (Trello, Slack, and Google Workspace)
- Keep shop, office, and build area cleans and organized

- Must have CAD design experience (Solidworks and Onshape preferred)
- Mill, lathe, and hand tool experience preferred
- Customer Service experience is desirable

Work Environment: This position operates in a professional office/ lab environment. This role routinely uses standard office equipment such as computers, phones, photocopiers, and is required to use a lab facility for development and testing of products. The employee may be exposed to fumes or airborne particles, moving mechanical parts, and vibration. This position may require you to assist with competitions in the *FIRST* program.
